

Tasting Room Hours – We are open seasonally from the first week of April through the Sunday before Christmas. Our normal business hours during this time are Thursday – Saturday from 12-9 and Sunday from 12-7. We are open on the following holidays: Mother’s Day, Memorial Day, Father’s Day, Independence Day and Labor Day.

Rosie’s Table Food Truck Hours – Our on-site food truck is open on Thursday from 5-8, Friday & Saturday from 12-8 and Sunday from 12-6.

Children– Children are welcome but must remain with their families and be supervised at all times. However, group reservations, tours, tastings, picnics and most ticketed events are 21+. The vineyard is a working farm and not safe for children to wander unattended. This rule is strictly enforced. Children are not allowed to sit at the bar. Children must wear shoes at all time as it is a safety hazard.

Dogs –Dogs are welcome on our patio and greenspace only. Dogs must be leashed at all times and kept with their owners. Picking up after your dog is mandatory. A pet service station is located behind the patio fireplace if you forgot your bags! Dogs are not allowed at ticketed events.

Outside Food & Drink– Outside food and drink is not permitted, this includes travel mugs and waters. Along with our regular drink menu, you can purchase sodas, waters, and snacks in our tasting room and food from our on-site food truck.

Entertainment Charge- Live music is intended to entertain our paying customers. There is a \$10 cover charge for guests who do not purchase food or drinks.

Cakes – Cakes can be brought in for a celebration if they come from a licensed/commercial bakery. A \$20 cake fee will be charged to the tab.

Payment & Process– We operate on a tab system and gratuities are pooled by all tasting room and food truck staff. Upon arrival, customers are prompted to open a tab with a credit card. A \$10 pre-authorization will be placed on the card that drops off within a few business days. Once a tab is opened, customers can order from either bar or the food truck. Abandoned tabs will be closed out for you at the end of the business day + an automatic 20% gratuity. You are welcome to pay as you go, however on busier days this does slow down the process which is why we encourage tabs. We do not have an in-house ATM. We accept cash, all major credit cards and Apple pay. Our tasting room and food truck staff work very hard to curate your entire experience at the vineyard which is not limited to simply pouring wine.

Bottles – We only sell bottles of wine to-go. We only sell wine by the glass to be consumed on-site. We do not sell bottles to be consumed on-site at the vineyard.

Holiday Closures - During the months we are open we are closed on Easter and Columbus Day

Reservations – We offer but do not require reservations to visit us or do a wine tasting. However, we ask that if you’re coming with a group of 6 or more, that you let us know in advance so we can prepare to serve you most comfortably.

Tickets – Ticketed events are regularly hosted at the vineyard for Corks & Crafts Nights, Comedy Nights, Food & Wine Pairings, special shows, etc. These events are typically 21+ and tickets must be purchased in advance to attend. Tickets are non-refundable but are transferable to another person if you can’t make it but want to give them to someone else. Ticketed events are either held in the tasting room or the event tent, depending on the event or time of year. If the event is sold out, we do not have extra tickets that we can sell or a waitlist system. Be cautious about people offering tickets to our events on-line or through social media as they are most likely scams.

Drink Options – We currently sell wine, wine-based drinks, craft cocktails and non-alcoholic craft mocktails as well as waters and sodas. We do not sell beer.

Parking – Please pay attention to the parking directional signs when arriving at the property. Private event parking is located at the back of the property and is separate from general tasting room parking. If you’re visiting for a private

event, do not park in the tasting room parking lot. If a parking attendant is assisting you with where to park, please follow their direction as parking is limited.

ADA – If you require assistance of a wheelchair we provide handicapped parking next to our patio for easier access to our tasting room. The handicapped accessible entrance is the patio door. Please keep in mind that our bathrooms are port-o-potties and not ADA accessible.

Bathrooms – We have two bathrooms located directly off of the tasting room. At the event tent, we have 2 pump-flush portable bathrooms with pump sinks.

Service Policy – Per state guidelines we have a strict serving policy at the vineyard. If any guest appears to be intoxicated, we reserve the right not to serve them. This decision is made by the server on a case-by-case basis and is not to be negotiated. If a guest is disrespectful of this policy, they will be asked to leave.

Groups – If you have a group of 6 or more planning to visit, just give us a call so we can prepare to accommodate you more comfortably. A deposit of \$50 is required to hold a group space for 6-15 and will be applied as a credit to your tab when you arrive. A deposit of \$300 (food & beverage minimum) is required for group reservations for 16-30 people. All group reservations are 21+

Entertainment – There's always something fun happening at vineyard. Live music every Saturday and Sunday and a host of other public events can be found on the "Music & Events" page of our website.

Tours – Absolutely! If you want a private tour, just contact us and we can schedule one! Tours are \$50 per person and include a wine tasting and we typically require a week's notice to book but might be able to accommodate earlier.

Picnics – The picnic package must be reserved in advance. The cost is \$75 per person and includes a wine flight and use of the picnic space for 2 hours. We ask that you reserve a picnic at least 48 hours in advance.

Limos, Busses & Shuttles – We have space for larger vehicle parking but we ask that you schedule your large group visit with us so we can prepare to accommodate you more comfortably. Larger vehicles must follow directional signs when entering the property and are not permitted to park in or drive through the regular customer parking lot.

Seating – We have ample seating in our tasting room, patio and greenspaces. But if you're coming for a large public event or festival, feel free to bring your own camping chairs in case we run out!
