

Schedule – Currently we are open seasonally from the first week of April through the Sunday before Christmas in December and that is subject to change in the future. Our normal business hours during this time are Thurs. – Sat. from 12-9 and Sun. from 12-7. We are open on the following holidays: Mother’s Day, Memorial Day, Father’s Day, Independence Day and Labor Day.

Holiday Closures - During the months we are open we are closed on Easter and Columbus Day

Reservations – We do not require reservations to visit us or do a wine tasting. However we ask that if you’re coming with a group of 8 or more, that you let us know in advance so we can prepare to serve you most comfortably.

Tickets – Ticketed events are regularly hosted at the vineyard for Maker Sessions, Comedy Nights, Special shows, etc. These events are typically 21+ and tickets must be purchased in advance to attend.

Children– Children are welcome but must remain with their families and be supervised at all times. The vineyard is a working farm and not safe for children to wander unattended. This rule is strictly enforced.

Food – Outside food and drink is not permitted, this includes travel mugs and coffees. You can purchase snacks in our tasting room and we have a rotating schedule of food trucks on Friday, Saturday and Sunday. Check out our events schedule to see the food truck line up. Starting in June of 2025 the vineyard will have its own food truck, open during all vineyard business hours.

Drink Options – We currently sell wine, wine-based drinks and non-alcoholic craft mocktails as well as waters and sodas in our farm store. We do not currently sell beer or spirits but are working on being able to add them in the future.

Dogs –Dogs are welcome on our patio and greenspace only. Dogs must be leashed at all times and kept with their owners. Picking up after your dog is mandatory. A pet service station is located behind the patio fireplace if you forgot your bags!

Bathrooms – There is no bathroom in the tasting room. We currently utilize port-o-potties located just outside the tasting room for your bathroom needs.

Service Policy – Per state guidelines we have a strict serving policy at the vineyard. If any guest appears to be intoxicated we reserve the right not to serve them. This decision is made by the server on a case-by-case basis and is not to be negotiated. If a guest is disrespectful of this policy, they will be asked to leave.

Large Groups – If you have a group of 8 or more planning to visit, just give us a call so we can prepare to accommodate you more comfortably.

Entertainment – There’s always something fun happening at vineyard. Live music every Saturday and Sunday and a host of other public events can be found on our website.

Tours – Absolutely! If you want a private tour, just contact us and we can schedule one!

Photography – While you’re visiting, feel free to walk in the vines and take photos. We also welcome professional photo shoots by appointment only. Contact us to schedule a time!

Limos, Busses & Shuttles – We have space for larger vehicle parking but we ask that you schedule your large group visit with us so we can prepare to accommodate you more comfortably. Larger vehicles must follow directional signs when entering the property and are not permitted to park in or drive through the regular customer parking lot.

Seating – We have ample seating in our tasting room, patio and greenspaces. But if you’re coming for a large public event or festival, feel free to bring your own camping chairs in case we run out!

ADA – If you require assistance of a wheelchair we provide handicapped parking next to our patio for easier access to our tasting room. The handicapped accessible entrance is the patio door. Please keep in mind that our bathrooms are port-o-potties and not ADA accessible.
